City Vacates Alley to Allow Lutheran Church Construction

An immediate start on the construction of a new Lutheran church on 14 Mile road, between Melton and Hereford roads, was foreseen this week when the city commission Monday night vacated an alley that parallels 14 Mile to the north.

The Rev. Howard G. Allward, who will be the new church's pastor, explained the church had purchased the entire block and needed the alley for playground, parking and church areas.

"The construction can begin tomorrow once the alley is vacated," he told the commission.

Plans call for early American style edifice, the first unit to cost an estimated \$40,000. A \$10,000 portable chapel will be erected for use while the main building is under construction.

His Ship Receives Navy Award for General Excellence

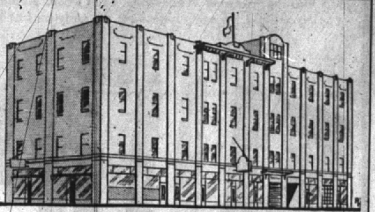
