Klein's Report Shows Increased Attendance at Springdale Park

Harold Klein, reporting last Thursday evening to the city plan commission on the public parks of Birmingham said that due to favorable publicity Springdale Park had enjoyed one of its busiest summers.

"There were a number of people in the city who did not know of its picnic facilities until this summer. Since that time they have been visiting the park quite often," Klein stated.

He added that a short time ago it was proposed that a part of the picnic grounds be added to the golf course.

"With the increase we have had this summer, this does not seem advisable at this time. In fact, the picnic area has been crowded on several occasions. The golf course has had a great deal of use this year, too. It has been suggested that there be an increase in fees for players outside of Birmingham, but no action has been taken as yet."

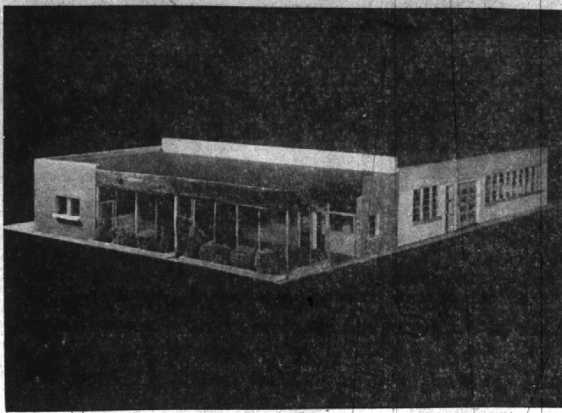
Klein reported that while the other parks in the city have had some use, none have shown the increase that Springdale has.

"The youngsters seem to like playing in vacant lots about as well as the parks. Of course, some are nearer their homes, which draws them. However, while all of our parks have been kept up this summer, none has been crowded at any time since the school vacations started."

Scale Model of Suburban Motors' New Building



This is a one-quarter inch scale model of the new Suburban Motors' building now under construction at 565 S. Woodward. It is owned by Richard A. Fischer, 630 Pilgrim, and Carl F. Fischer, 783 Pilgrim. The brothers established their present location at 314 E. Maple about a year ago.

Their present building will be of the latest design. It is a one-floor plan of cinder block and brick, measuring 70 x 115 feet. The area across the front will house a two-car display room and offices.

The repair space in back will have the latest repair and testing equipment for all types of cars. The building is fireproof and designed for maximum efficiency. Adjacent to the building a large hard top parking area is being built for customers. The schedule calls for construction to be completed November 1.

10 Local Boys Complete Course at Grosse Ile

One hundred young men received a certificate yesterday at the Grosse Ile Naval Air Station, signifying the completion of an eight weeks indoctrination course in the Navy.

Among the group from Birmingham were William F. Renfrew, Frank E. Colby, Harry S. Gruber, Russell W. Layland, Jr., Leo C. Hanson, Walter S. McPhail, Gerald J. Lange, Herbert J. Strasser, Jr., Robert H. Brown, Jr., and John A. Fricker, II, of Franklin.

As the parents and friends of the group watched the colorful ceremony, the Recruit Class passed in their last review before Captain James P. Walker, Commanding Officer of the Grosse Ile Base.

This class, a post war innovation in the Naval Reserve was made up of high school graduates from the Detroit metropolitan area. The men reported to Grosse Ile eight weeks ago as civilians without prior military service. Now they are ready to take their place with the veterans of World War II in the Organized Reserve at Grosse Ile.

Under the direction of Lt. Commander Walter J. Davidson, USNR, a course of study has been completed, including military training, seamanship, ordnance and gunnery, physical training and general recruit indoctrination.

"We are gratified at the results of the first class," said Captain Walker. "The personnel are to be complimented on the fine record they have made. We now welcome them as active members of the Organized Reserve Squadrons and look forward to their future development in the Reserve Program."
