George Dunn, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Dunn, 1561 Bates, Birmingham, who completed his football career at Western Michigan College this fall, had the distinct honor of being selected by his teammates on the Bronco gridiron team as the most valuable player, a selection made each year by the

players themselves while the coaches pick the most improved. George, who started with the Bronco gridiron forces as a half-back, was shifted to quarterback a year ago and while he played to some extent offensively he was used for the greater part in the platoon system, as the defensive quarterback and again this year he played the defensive role.

Time and again during the season playing the safety spot Dunn nipped runners when he was the final man between the runner and the goal, and cut down heavily on the opponents' scoring.

Dunn also proved most adept in running back punts and it was a 55-yard punt return in the final game against Western Reserve of Cleveland in the Mid-American Conference which put the Western Michigan team in position for its final touchdown, which gave the Broncos a 21-14 win over the Red Cats.

Dunn also entered the Bronco lineup to kick the extra points after touchdown this year, booting 16 extra points out of 22 attempts.
