

### CROP Train to Be Dedicated Jan. 18

Mrs. S. Kenneth Kuhn of Gilbert Lake, local chairman of the Christian Rural Overseas Program, has announced that local contributions may be sent to her by addressing them to Box 72 at the Birmingham post office.

"In each case," she explained, "a receipt will be sent to the donor. I might also add that these contributions are deductible from income tax, as they are going to a recognized cause."

The CROP quota for Oakland County is two carloads of food (one of processed grains, the other of dried milk) for overseas relief. The total cost of these will be about \$1,000. Because Oakland County is primarily an industrial rather than agricultural section, Mrs. Kuhn said that most of the food would be purchased.

Individuals sending money gifts may designate to which of the many churches sponsoring the drive they would like the credit to go.

CROP has already shipped 135 carloads of food abroad with the Christmas Spirit Food Train which left this country last month. The present drive is to be ready for shipping about the middle of the month, although some areas which were unable to get their program organized promptly, will make their shipments at a slightly later date. Present plans are for the train to be assembled at Durand, Mich., on Jan. 18, where a dedication ceremony will be held. Following this the cars will be sent to the eastern ports for overseas transportation.

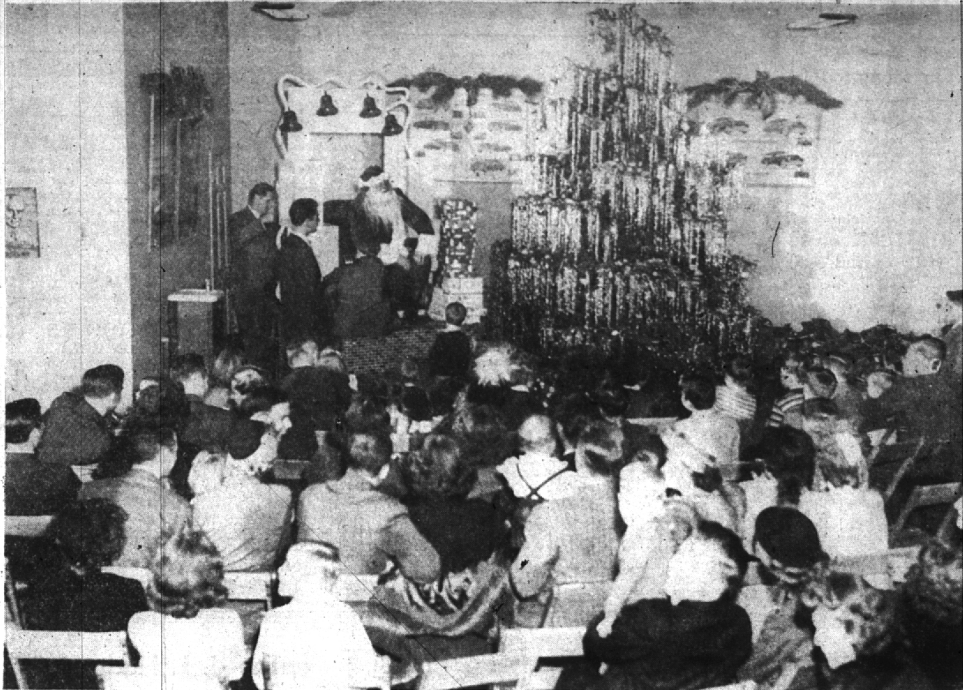

### New Exhibits Open At Cranbrook

Four new exhibits open Tuesday, Jan. 11, at the Museum of Cranbrook Academy of Art—the Rome Collaborative competition, the J. L. Hudson collection, "Michigan on Canvas," the St. Louis Jefferson Memorial competition and "Rocks and Clay," a comparative exhibition of ceramics.

The Rome Collaborative was one in which an architect, landscape architect, painter and sculptor might work together in creating the "showplace of America," which the head of a large cosmetic firm wanted as a design for a showroom and plant. Among the 12 drawings selected for this tour is one by three Cranbrook students, William Meechow and Donald Knorr, architects and Matt Kahn, painter, which was awarded the first prize of \$200.00.

**Original Drawings**  
There are 35 original drawings from the St. Louis Jefferson Memorial competition, which is being circulated by the American Federation of Arts. Competition for this memorial structure drew entries from every part of the country. The first prize, which was awarded \$40,000, included the work of Eero Saarinen, Bloomfield Hills; J. Henderson Barr, Birmingham and Lily Swann Saarinen, Bloomfield Hills. A Cranbrook student, William Eng, also shared in the second prize entry of \$20,000.

The ceramics display of ceramics is presented by Robert Lohman of the Cranbrook School Arts department.
