The Michigan State Highway Department has chalked The Michigan State Highway Department has chalked up another "first" by receiving Public Roads Administration approval of its program for installation of a complete new modern sign system on the 9,400 miles of state trunsline in the state," Highway Commissioner Charles H. Ziegler announced this week.

Thus, Michigan becomes the first state in the nation to start plans for replacing its old and inadequate highway signs with new, modern signs under the uniform system adopted for all states by state and federal highway agencies as provided for under the Federal Highway Act of 1944.

The new sign system will cost approximately \$1,500,000 with the Federal government participating in the cost on a 50-50 basis
