Effective July 2-**NEW LONG DISTANCE TELEPHONE RATES** for calls within Michigan

NCREASED RATES for long distance telephone calls between Michigan points, effective July 2, 1949, have been authorized by the Michigan Public Service

Last December, Michigan Bell requested rate increases for both local telephone service and long distance service within Michigan so it might conue giving the kind of telephone service the people of Michigan demand.

The Public Service Commission's order provides only for that part of the application which requested an increase application which requested an increase in long distance rates (including rates for teletypewriter exchange service mes-usges) within the state. But it will pro-vide urgently needed revenue until the Commission is able to finish its investion of the complete request and rule

HERE'S WHAT THE NEW RATES MEAN

Initial-period rates for DAY STATION-TO-STATION calls are increased 5¢ to 15¢, depending on the distance.

Initial-period rates for NIGHT STA-TION-TO-STATION calls are increased 5¢ to 30¢, depending on the distance.

Initial-period rates for DAY PERSON-TO-PERSON calls are increased 5¢ to 30¢, depending on the distance.

Initial-period rates for NIGHT PER-SON-TO-PERSON calls are increased 5¢ to 45¢, depending on the distance. Rates for each additional minute, which are approximately V_3 of the initial-period rate, are increased proportionately.

The initial period for 10¢ calls on the new rate schedule is 4 instead of 5 minutes; and for 20¢ calls, 3 instead of 4 minutes.

Rates for teletypewriter exchange service messages between Michigan points are increased proportionately.
