Maples (Continued from Page One) McGinnis and Joe Ross chased Ypsi's Dave Hill to the top, both breaking the second school record when they were clocked at 31.5 and 31.6, bettering Frank McCarty's 1937 record of 31.7.

The Maple medal relay team, consisting of Eric Heizer, Jere McMillin, Bob Polin and Sandy Gruber, set a new school and state record at 2:23.4. The Maple quartet finished 15 yards ahead of Ypsilanti when Polin gave Gruber a tremendous lead.

The next race was the straw that broke the camel's back. Pressed very hard by McMillin, Joe Ross was clocked in 31.4 for first place in the 100 yard dash. That put the Maples well in front with 32 points to Ypsi's 18.

Points Keep Coming Polin seized the Maples' third individual state crown when he beat Ross in the 220. In the high jump McGinnis and Tim Reed tied for sixth place with four others.

The outstanding performer of the day was Ypsi's Dave Hill who took first and set new state records in the high hurdles at 14.4; broad jump at 22 feet 1 1/2 inches; and low hurdles, 22.7. He also tied for third in the high jump which he had won in 1947 and '48. Hill scored 21 of Ypsi's 29 points.
