Chief Cites Good Manners As Route To Traffic Safety

During the past few months, while accident reports throughout the country have risen, those in Birmingham have shown a slight decrease, Police Chief Ralph W. Moxley said this week. He felt part of the drop was due to the fact that the men in his department have done everything within their power to check local violations.

"The rest of it is due to our local drivers," Moxley said. "They have watched our monthly accident reports and have become aware of the principal causes of accidents, and have, in many cases, improved their driving for safety reasons."

Good Manners Can Help.
"Obeying speed laws and traffic signs is not the only means of cutting accidents," he said. "Driving a safe car is one way, of course, but good manners can also do a great deal. This has been brought out more strongly to police departments since the publication, by the National Highway Users Conference of Motor Manners.

The Blue Book of Traffic Etiquette" by Emily Post."
In her book Mrs. Post wrote: "Behind the wheel of a car men and women whose behavior in all other circumstances is beyond reproach, become suddenly transformed into bad-manners auto-

crats. Primitive, irresponsible, discourteous and impatient behavior behind the wheel of an automobile has no place in society. Our legislators have attempted to establish safe driving rules in motor vehicle laws. . . The well bred person will notice courteous and well-mannered human conduct in practically every rule."

Four Basic Rules.
Mrs. Post brought out four rules which Moxley said he believed would aid greatly in cutting accidents if they were adhered to closely. The rules are:
A well-mannered driver will share the road, never usurping the right-of-way from vehicles and pedestrians.

An honorable man or woman would no more cheat traffic regulations than cheat at games or in sports.
Courteous pedestrians will cross busy streets at intersections, respect traffic lights and avoid darting out from behind parked vehicles.

Considerate persons always drive at speeds which are reasonable and prudent, considering traffic, road and weather conditions.

Hospital Pharmacy Plays a Vital Role



"The physician's arsenal" is a term aptly applied to the modern hospital pharmacy. Here are stocked most of the doctor's weapons for his fight against disease. The new Southern Oakland Hospital, to be built in this area with the help of the Greater Detroit Hospital Fund, will have a modern, completely equipped pharmacy department, similar to the one maintained at Harper Hospital, where this picture was taken. The pharmacist shown here is diluting streptomycin.

Many of the facilities at St. Joseph Mercy, Pontiac, and nine other Detroit hospitals will be expanded when the \$19,720,000 objective of the Fund is reached. Three other new hospitals, in addition to Southern Oakland, also will be built as part of the program.

Careful Consideration
The role of the hospital pharmacy in the care of patients throughout Oakland County is a vital one, and in planning the new 200-bed Southern Oakland Hospital to be built in this community, hospital authorities have given the pharmacy careful consideration. It has been planned to give patients prompt service, and there will be available the new and powerful pharmaceuticals that have been developed recently.

The hospital pharmacist is one of the many unsung heroes who contribute to the care of a patient. He is a vital link in the chain of medical service. His contributions are not so widely heralded as those of hospital colleagues because careful compounding of prescriptions and dispensing pharmaceuticals is a behind-the-scenes procedure.

The hospital pharmacist must keep abreast of developments in his field. As soon as a new drug is approved, a new remedy, doctors in the hospital begin to use it and the pharmacy must have a stock on hand. Likewise when an old remedy has been superseded by a more effective one, the hospital doctors stop using it and the hospital pharmacy ceases to stock it.

Increased Responsibility
Recent advances in medical science have greatly increased the work and responsibility of the hospital pharmacist. First came the biologicals, the serums and vaccines, in a new technique of preventive medicine. The pharmacist had to find space and acquire new equipment to handle these. As new serums were discovered, more and more shelf space had to be given to them.

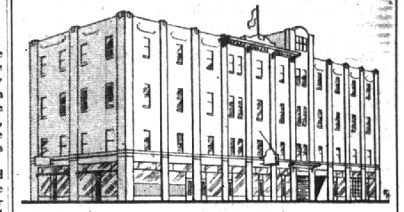
