

### Culver Polo Team To Play Detroit's Gold Hats Sunday

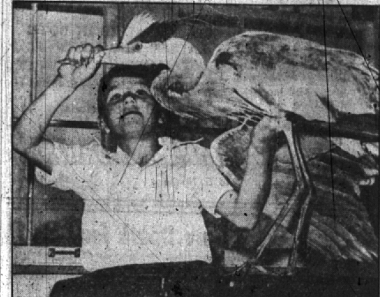

Al Poole, playing No. 1, led the scoring for the Gold Hats with five goals. Volney Bayley accounted for three, Harold Troy two and two pony goals.

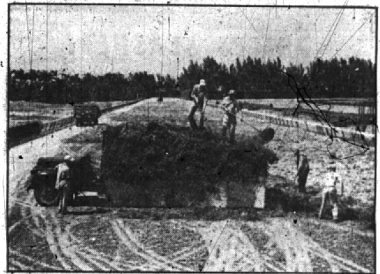

### Race Track Doubles as Farm



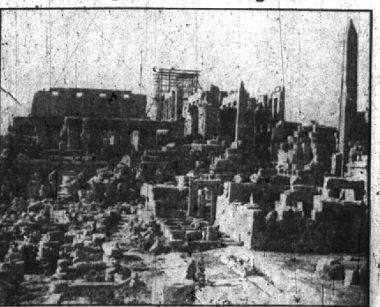
