## 12 New Records Established in Junior Olympics Saturday

Many phases of the real Olympic games were exemplified at Pierce Field last Saturday afternoon at the Birmingham Fifteenth Quarterback Club staged the fifth annual Junior Olympic Games for the junior athletes of the community.

The weather cooperated with the promotion and the stands were filled as the big track and field meet was run off under blue skies and a bright sun, the first in nearly a week.

Bill Porter, Birmingham resident and former Big Ten and Olympic hurdles champion, helped the quarterbacks stage the event. As an added feature he ran the high hurdles, displaying the form that wrote a new world record into the books at London last summer. He ran alone and was untimed.

**Win Special Trophies**  
Winners of the special Junior Olympic Trophies were Dick Dexter, age 11, who heaved the shot 23 feet, nine-and-one-half inches; Mickey Plumstead, age 13, who high jumped four feet and seven inches for a new record. Mickey is only four feet and six inches tall and he won the trophy in his specialty for the second year.

Art Fairbanks, who is 15 years old, set a new broad jump record in Class "A", with a leap of 19 feet 2 3/4 inches. It was Art's second trophy, too. In the open class, Toby Maxwell turned in a 2:02.2 half mile. Toby is 17 and a high school track star at Cranbrook. A number of records fell in each of the four classes. Two in Class "C", five in Class "B", two in Class "A" and three in the open division.
