Experimental Farm

Two hundred acres at North-western Highway and Ten-and-a-half Mile road, are devoted to bringing bigger, better and healthier cattle and poultry to the farmers of Michigan.

Each year many thousands of animals are bred and housed there for the development of scientific feeding. More than 125 buildings are spread out over the large area. They include an X-Ray department, incubators, bull pens, maternity barns and experimental laboratory.

Under Observation. At present 60 weaning pigs are under observation with 900 calves and 2,000 dogs being used in the experimental feedings.

Bronze broad-breasted turkeys are penned according to the effect of builder diet on their market value. More than 48,000 birds and their histories have been brought to the farm since its inception.

Walking through the grounds is a revelation because of the absence of clutter, the neatness of the buildings, well spaced housing conditions and well trimmed grass. At certain hours of the day thousands of white Leghorns dot the premises like a mantle of snow.

"Battery feeding studies are used extensively to screen new formulas," Emerick said.
