Miss Strauss and other members of the group are reassembling in Washington on Oct. 18 for a "Report to the People" to be presented over America's Town Meeting of the Air.

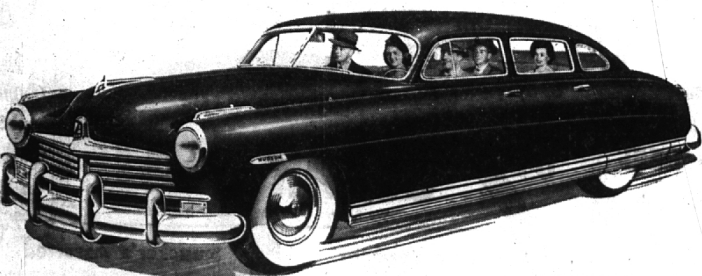
