Desserts Are Made Very Quickly With This Homemade Mix

Green apple dumplings, strawberry-rhubarb shortcake—these combinations are quick work when a homemaker keeps a supply of homemade biscuit mix in her refrigerator.

In making this homemade mix, all the ingredients except the liquid are combined, then placed in a covered jar in the refrigerator. When dumplings, biscuits or shortcake time comes, the homemaker simply takes out the amount of mix she needs and adds just enough milk to make a soft dough.

Homemade Biscuit Mix

8 cups sifted flour
 1/4 cup baking powder
 4 teaspoons salt
 1 1/2 cups lard for hard wheat flour or
 1 cup lard for soft wheat flour

Sift flour again with the baking powder and salt. Cut in the lard until the mixture has a fine even crumb. Cover mix closely and store in the refrigerator. This mixture will keep at least a month in the refrigerator. To make a dozen medium-sized biscuits add one-half cup of milk to two cups mix. Yield: 10 cups of mix.
