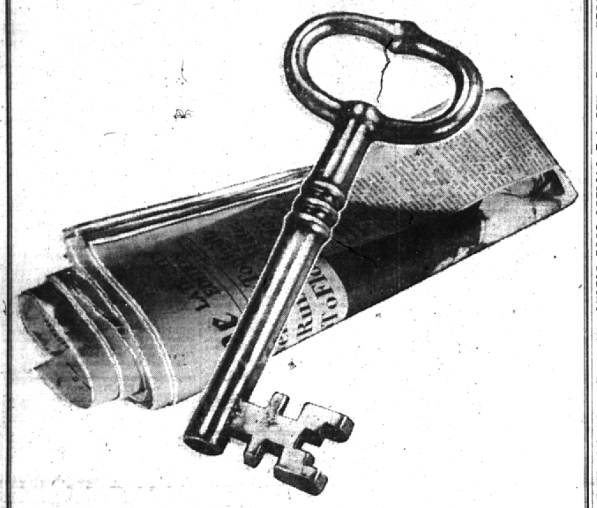
Town Hall to Open New Lecture Series on Friday, Oct. 14
