## Southfield Man Returns From Mission in Europe

SOUTHFIELD—Herman F. Luhrs, 26716 Meadowbrook way, has returned from Europe where he was serving as an envoy for the "Tide of Toys" program.

More than 3,000 toys were distributed by the four-man group, sponsored by the American Legion. Luhrs reported the group visited orphanages and made presentations in Frankfurt, Berlin, Vienna, Paris, Rome, London, Glasgow and Limerick, Ireland.

During their visit to Rome, the men were received by the Pope and presented him a scroll commending him on his work against communism. Luhrs described the Pope as "very friendly and most gracious in acknowledging the gesture of goodwill from our American children to the youngsters in Europe."

HE SAID THAT in Frankfurt, while Legion representatives were present, Communist rabble-rousers staged a protest parade which was disregarded.

"It is a common occurrence whenever any American mission arrives," he said.

About conditions overseas, Luhrs commented, "We found general conditions good, especially in Germany where the people are working hardest to recover."

"Food is plentiful in France, Italy and Austria. Paris has upped food prices to Americans, but the French are not charged equally."

"Building is booming and material seems to be plentiful."

"The American zone is in better condition than any other part of Berlin. The stores are well stocked and have attractive window displays to draw trade."

"IN ENGLAND rationing is still in force. Food, along with all clothing except utility wear, is scarce and of poor quality."

"Much of Berlin has not yet recovered," Luhrs said. "Damaged buildings still stand as depressing reminders of the horror of war."

"There is great tension in Berlin—you can feel it everywhere. The people there are hoping for peace, but the consensus seems to be that war is inevitable."

"The Salvation Army operates a shelter in Berlin, housing some 150 persons. Families of four and six live in quarters only nine feet square. They have no sunlight and live in the most terrible conditions, as far as sanitation is concerned."

LUHRS REPORTED that on the outskirts of Frankfurt, bomb shelters are still being used for housing units.

## R. M. Kyes Succeeds Morgan D. Douglas in GMC Position

Appointment of Roger M. Kyes as general manager of the GMC truck and coach division of General Motors has been announced by C. E. Wilson, president.

Kyes, assistant general manager of GMC truck and coach since last October, succeeds Morgan D. Douglas who is taking a leave of absence because of his health.

Douglas has been with General Motors for 35 years. He served with the Chevrolet division for 30 years, including 16 years as general parts and accessories manager, before his appointment as general manager of the GMC truck and coach division five years ago.

Kyes joined General Motors in August, 1948, and served as director of its central office procurement and schedules staff until his appointment to the GMC division in October, 1949.

HE SERVED as assistant to the president of the Glenn L. Martin Co. for two years. In 1929, Kyes became assistant to the vice-president of Black and Decker manufacturing company at Towson, Md. Two years later he was made vice-president of the Empire plow company at Cleveland.

In 1941 Kyes joined the Ferguson-Sherman manufacturing corporation (later Harry Ferguson, Inc.) as executive vice-president and general manager, and in 1943 became president and general manager. He resigned from the Ferguson company in November, 1947.

Kyes is a member of the Union club of Cleveland, the Orchard Lake country club, the Detroit club, the Bloomfield Hills country club, the Detroit Athletic club and the Revere club.

Doss is vice-president in charge of sales for the Nash-Kelvinator corporation.

In making the announcement, W. Brooke Stabler, headmaster, revealed that this is the second such scholarship received, named after a Cranbrook alumnus. The gift will enable the school to grant aid to an additional boarding student for the school year beginning in September.

AT THE TIME of his death, Clay was a student at Stanford university. He had transferred to that school from Yale last fall. A leader of his class while at Cranbrook, Clay was active in athletics and student religious and supervisory work.

At Cranbrook graduation ceremonies in June 1948, he was selected by his classmates as the school's "most respected senior" and was awarded with membership in the Cum Laude society in recognition of superior academic achievement.
