

### B'ham Estates Street Surfacing Delayed 10 Days

Asphaltic concrete will be laid in the Birmingham Estates Street improvement district "within the next thirty days," the residents' association was notified by the City Commission this week through Association President Forrest Hubert.

Original plans called for the work to be done this week, but City Manager Donald C. Egbert reported that while the base was being prepared workmen found the top inch of gravel contained an excess of asphaltic oil and the gravel immediately below the oil was saturated with water.

The result was a "spongy" top

level of gravel, Egbert said. Streets in the area will have to be reworked in order to supply a firm base for the concrete, he added.

The contractor will remove his operation to a two-day job in Pontiac while the DPW repairs the streets, reworks the oil and reruns the base, Egbert announced.

### LEGAL NOTICES

**ORDINANCE NO. 405**  
City of Birmingham  
Parking Meter Ordinance  
An Ordinance relating to traffic and regulating the use of public streets, highways and public parking places in the City of Birmingham, providing for the location of individual parking spaces, regulating the use of such parking spaces, and providing for and relating to the use of parking meters in connection therewith, and to repeal Ordinance No. 224, 241, 251, and in connection therewith, the City of Birmingham, Michigan.

**Section 1. DEFINITIONS.** In this Ordinance, the following words and phrases shall have the meaning hereinafter ascribed to them: "Vehicle" shall mean any device in, on, or upon any public street, highway or other public place, except a device which is an integral part of a building or structure.

**PARKING METER** shall mean a mechanical device which shall indicate the length of time during which a vehicle may be parked in a particular place which shall have as a part thereof a meter or meter face, which shall be so constructed that it will receive and retain coins of the United States and which shall be so constructed that it will indicate the amount of time for which parking is being purchased, and which shall display an appropriate signal when the stored-up credit for parking has expired.

**INDIVIDUAL PARKING SPACE** shall mean a portion of the paved surface of the street or public ground of sufficient length and depth from the curb to allow the parking and accommodate a vehicle to be parked.

**PERSON** shall mean and include any individual, firm, partnership, or corporation, or group of two or more persons, or any vehicle, machine, and the machine and feminine gender.

**PUBLIC PARKING PLACES (LOTS)** shall mean any area of land used for the parking of vehicles, owned or operated by any city or town.

**OPERATOR** shall mean and include any person who shall operate a vehicle as the owner thereof or as the agent, partner, employee, licensee, or permittee of the owner.

**ETC.** shall mean any public way, avenue, road, boulevard, highway, public place or other place, open for vehicle travel, located in the City of Birmingham and established by ordinance, purchase, lease or otherwise, for the use and enjoyment of the public.

**PARKING METER ZONE:** Section 2. The City Commission shall have the authority to establish or abandon parking meter zones, and by resolution or ordinance, to establish or modify such zones, and to include within any "Parking Meter Zone" any area which is not included within any "Public Parking Lot."

**Section 3. INDIVIDUAL PARKING SPACES:** The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to designate and mark off each individual parking space and to direct and direct such spaces, and to direct such spaces, and to direct such spaces, and to direct such spaces.

**Section 4. PARKING METERS:** The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to direct the placement, installation, and maintenance of parking meters in any parking meter zone, and to direct the placement, installation, and maintenance of parking meters in any parking meter zone.

**Section 5. PARKING FEE:** The City Commission is hereby authorized to empower to establish fees for the parking of vehicles in any parking meter zone, and to establish such fees, and to establish such fees.

**Section 6. VIOLATIONS:** Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall be liable to a penalty of ten dollars, and to a fine of ten dollars, and to a fine of ten dollars.
