

### Vote Asked on Fire Hall Issue In Southfield

The Southfield township board received petitions Monday requesting the matter of more fire protection facilities be placed on the Sept. 12 ballot.

The board will hold a special meeting tomorrow evening at 7:30 to consider the petitions.

Approximately 100 persons attended a special township meeting Monday in Lathrup school, which was held to "discuss additional fire protection facilities for Southfield township."

The meeting was called by the township board after it received a petition signed by 78 residents requesting the action.

THE PETITIONS submitted Monday asked that township residents vote on the following proposal: "That the township expend appropriate funds for two fire halls with underwritten approved equipment, to be built by Dec. 31, 1951 and financed by the township's building and site fund."

The suggested sites for the fire halls are the southwest corner of the township, and the 13 Mile Evergreen area.

Claude Whipple, president of the Beverly Hills-Greenfield protective association, outlined the importance of considering additional fire facilities. He gave the following reasons for desiring more fire halls:

- "(1) THE township's population has increased over 6,000 persons during the last decade.
  - "(2) 2000-4000 building permits have been issued during the past two years.
  - "(3) If two or more fires broke out at the same time, the present single department would be handicapped.
  - "(4) The country is faced with war and the township needs to furnish adequate protection."
- Whipple said that at a special meeting in December 1948, a master plan for additional fire protection facilities was discussed and set up at a special township meeting. At that time the board was authorized to purchase four sites for fire halls.

THE SITES were in the vicinity of Nine Mile and Telegraph, 12 Mile and Telegraph, 13 Mile and Evergreen and 10 Mile and Evergreen. Since that time, property was purchased and a hall erected at the latter site.

Township Supervisor D. P. Frame said negotiations have been underway for some time to purchase land for the fire halls but it is a slow process to acquire sites. He added, "All things take time. We don't get answers right away from the property owners."

It was brought up by several advocates of the proposal that even if taxes were raised to finance the cost of additional fire protection, residents would "save money" through lower fire insurance rates.

At the present time, Southfield has a class 10 rating for fire insurance. With additional fire halls, it was pointed out that most of the area would have a class eight rating and about one-third of the present insurance rate would be reduced.

IN APPEALING for the matter to be placed on the September ballot, Whipple said, "We don't want any railing of this important and serious matter. We want this placed before all the people on the ballot."

Sponsors of the plan, expressed the opinion that two fire halls could be constructed for \$55,000. At the present time, \$50,000 is in the township's building and site fund.

Frame pointed out that he was in favor of more fire protection facilities but he warned, "We must consider what we want and how much it will cost. We want water, roads and schools but there is just so much money to work with."

Last May, the township board appropriated \$18,600 for fire equipment, but Frame said the county allocation board hasn't allowed that amount to be used for this purpose as yet.

He added if the money was used for fire equipment, the township school board would lose that amount from its appropriation.

At the present time, Southfield township has 36 square miles served by a nine-man department.

After all the discussion on the proposal, the audience voted that the petitions should be submitted to the board requesting a vote be held Sept. 12.

### City Annexes Site For 3rd Water Tank

Annexation by resolution of 5.83 acres of city property on Derby road immediately east of the railroad district took place at the city commission meeting Monday evening.

The property was acquired by the city in developing a site for a third water storage tank.

A portion of Croydon road is involved in the project and the commission will consider its closing at a public hearing Sept. 11.

### Body of Aged Man Found by Neighbors

Alfonso W. Lee, 2961 Crooks road, was found dead in his home Tuesday by neighbors. He was 82 years old.

Dr. Isaac Prevette, deputy coroner for Oakland county, said the man had died Friday from natural causes.

The only known survivor is a granddaughter, Mrs. June Adams of Kalamazoo.

The body is at the Bell funeral home pending arrangements.
