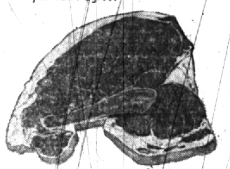

Canadian Rail Strike Halts Mail Delivery

The Birmingham postoffice has received an official notice from the postmaster general which states:

"Effective at once, due to a temporary suspension of railway service in Canada, only the following classes of mail, paid at the surface or air mail rates, may be accepted for delivery in that country.

"Letters and post cards in their usual form. "Parcels, letter packages or eight-ounce merchandise packages containing medicines, specimens for medical analysis, or similar urgent shipments. "Any articles or parcels in transit after the receipt of this order shall be forwarded in normal channels to the appropriate exchange office."

The notice was released for public information here by Acting Postmaster Bernard E. Fowler.
