

Last Rites Held For R. C. Traub Detroit Jeweler

Robert C. Traub, 83, president of the Traub Brothers and company, retail jewelers in Detroit, died at his home on West Long Lake road Wednesday, Dec. 16. He was the son of Christian Traub who, with his brother Jacob, descendants of a family of Bavarian silversmiths, founded the business in 1850. Mr. Traub had spent many years in the firm, learning the business from his father and uncle

and upon their deaths, assuming command of the firm. He was born in Detroit on Feb. 19, 1867 and had spent his entire life in this area. He was a member of the Bloomfield Hills country club and a charter member of the Detroit Boat club. **HE IS SURVIVED** by his wife Elizabeth and one daughter, Mrs. Merrill Olin Bates of Bloomfield Hills. Services were held Monday morning from his residence, with burial in Elmwood cemetery, Detroit. The Rev. Charles H. Assessment Districts Considered by City Commission

Necessity of creating special assessment districts on Pembroke road, Pembroke court and Mansfield, Sheffield and Bradford was approved by the city commission Monday evening. In addition, the commission approved the assessment roll for paving in Pembroke Manor. There were no objections at the hearing for consideration of a special district to defray the cost of paving on Pembroke road from Eton to Graceland and paving on Pembroke court from Graceland west. The necessity was approved for construction of concrete paving with integral curb on Mansfield from Sheffield to Bradford; Sheffield from Eton to Mansfield; Bradford from Eton to Mansfield; Pembroke; Manchester from St. Andrews to Coolidge; Windermere from St. Andrews to Coolidge; and Buckingham from St. Andrews to Coolidge. Estimated cost of this project is \$102,150 and the commission authorized the payments to be made in five yearly installments. **Use Classified Ads—They Sell!**
