The Birmingham high school swimming squad dropped a 45-35 decision to Ferdale last Tuesday afternoon at Ferdale.

The Maple Swimmers had swamped the Ferdale tank men during the past two years of Eastern Michigan league competition, but this contest was the Rail-splitters' all the way as they swam to six first places.

The meet's only double winner was Mike Daugherty, Ferdale, who paddled to victory in the 100-yard breast stroke and the 150-yard individual medley.

The Maple menmen captured three first places, all in free style events. Don Goldsmith, veteran free styler, placed to a win in the 200-yard event with a time of 2:20.4. Marc Joslyn swam the 100-yard event in 1:00.8.

The 200-yard free style team of Al Fremody, Gary Osterbeck, Jim Newman, and Marc Joslyn has shown the way so far this season.

In the opening meet with Hazel Park, these boys shattered former event, swimming it in 1:46.9. At Ferdale they broke their own distance mark, negotiating the distance in 1:46.2.
