Four years were required to complete the book and the finished volume weighs 24 pounds and opens to a width of 30 inches. The large size of the page necessitates the rebuilding of one of the sewing machines at the bindery and it was also found necessary to back it by hand since there is no machine large enough for this size.

Copies of this Bible were also presented to the Library of Congress and to the New York Public Library.
