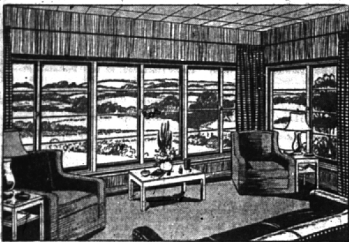

Nation's Youngest Newspaperman May Be 8-Year-Old B'ham Editor

Young Editor at Work

Birmingham has an active contestant for the title of the country's youngest editor in David Lougee of 324 Greenwood.

David, who is eight years old, is editor, reporter, printer, art director, copy boy and general manager of "Neighborhood News", a weekly publication.

He began his journalistic and editorial career 12 weeks ago, while trying to occupy his time during a bout with the measles. It proved so much fun to make newspapers that when he recovered, he took it up seriously.

Mrs. Arthur Lougee, his mother, serves as secretary for the young man, and types all copy. At present the paper is done entirely on the typewriter with carbon copies. David is saving his money to purchase a mimeograph and will really get rolling then.

ALTHOUGH THE PAPER is only 12 weeks old, there are already 12 paid subscribers (probably 14 by the time you read this) with some in Maine, Dearborn and Greene Pointe.

The current issue has a five-color design in keeping with the spring season. David, a student at Quarton school, makes his own linoleum blocks and does his own printing.

The news is gathered by telephoning his neighbors and completely covers the comings and goings of folks in the area. In addition to this, he tries to have a feature story each week.

While some of the issues were of two pages, the April 14 copy has gone into the three-page bracket.

David's father, Arthur Lougee, is art director for the Ford Motor company's publications.

Next Fall May See Only 9th Grade in New Twp. School

SOUTHFIELD—It is probable that only ninth grade students will be accommodated this fall at the new Southfield township high school now under construction on Lahar and Ten Mile roads, according to Glenn Schoenhals, superintendent of schools. Plans for units A and B now

under construction to be completed in September. These units consist of several class rooms, drawing room, home economics department, bus garage and storage space.

Schoenhals said it was originally hoped to take tenth grade students this fall but it looks as if enrollment will have to be limited to ninth graders. Construction of the third unit will be advertised June 2 and bids will be taken June 19. This unit, which will be the main part of the building, will include laboratories, classrooms and library.
