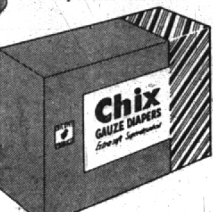

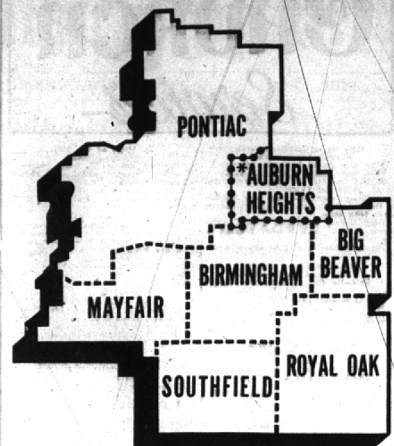

Nearly 77,000 telephones in this and five adjacent communities will be available to extended-area subscribers here at a flat monthly charge beginning June 18. At that time Pontiac's 27,000 telephones will be added to some 50,000 presently included in the plan. Birmingham customers who choose to subscribe to local service only will pay a 5c charge to call Pontiac and after June 18.

Another 27,000 telephones will be within reach of subscribers to extended-area service here when dial service makes its debut on June 18.

Presently limited to Big Beaver, Mayfair, Royal Oak, and Southfield, extended-area users also will

get Pontiac toll-free after the dial cutover.
The present 10 cent toll charge for calls from Pontiac will be eliminated for extended-area subscribers. For those customers having only local service, a 5 cent charge will apply.

RATES FOR the broader service are based on the number of telephones which can be reached at a flat monthly charge. Birmingham customers who subscribe to the plan will pay a higher rate when Pontiac is added to the calling area.
Walter H. Fauser, manager here for the Michigan Bell Telephone Company, said Birmingham extended-area plan would include nearly 77,000 telephones, with the addition of Pontiac.

"This modern telephone communications plan is Michigan Bell's answer to the trend of present-day living habits," Fauser said. "It recognizes that people today live in one community, work in another, and sometime do their marketing in yet a third."

"Michigan Bell has invested some \$2,400,000 in a metropolitan dial telephone system for Birmingham. When this is out in service, it will permit all our customers here to dial more than 700,000 telephones directly, without the assistance of an operator."

"ALL DETROIT, Pontiac, Mayfair, Southfield, Center Line, Royal Oak and Mt. Clemens telephones will be as easy to call as your next-door neighbor."
"Automatic Message Accounting equipment, an 'electrical brain' which records details on short-haul toll calls for billing purposes, makes this direct tie-in possible."

Fauser emphasized that the extended-area plan is offered Birmingham customers on an optional basis.
TOLL-FREE CALLS to the nearby exchanges included in the plan are available only to those customers who subscribe to the broader type of service. Subscribers to local service only will pay a message-unit charge for calls to those adjacent communities.

However, Fauser said that all Birmingham users will be able to take advantage of the direct dialing facilities the new system will provide. The "AMA" equipment will record all information required to properly bill each customer for the calls he makes.

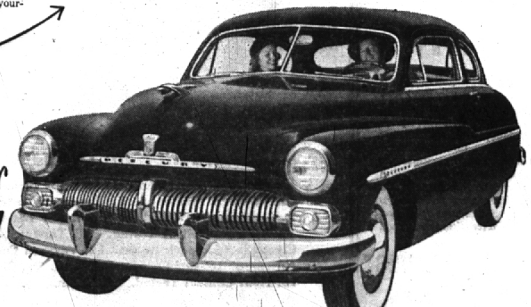
