

Another Zoning Ordinance Hearing Slated in Hills

Another public hearing has been scheduled to discuss the proposed New Bloomfield Hills zoning ordinance.

The city commission Tuesday evening called a public hearing for Monday evening, Dec. 27 at 8, if the Vaughan school auditorium is available. A previous public hearing was held two months ago to discuss this matter but the planning commission recommended this week that a few more changes in cubic contents of dwellings be made.

The proposed ordinance stipulates a minimum cubic content for dwellings in some instances and maximum in others.

In other business, the commission granted permission to the Grand Trunk railway to move Trembridge road farther back from the tracks and to cut the bank away.
