

# Russian DP's Still Await Better Life

## Their Only Crime: Disliking Present Soviet Government

(Edit. Note—This is the last article of the current European series written by Robert Ball. The fortnightly articles have covered problems today in eleven European countries.)

**SALZBURG, Austria**—Across from the Salzburg railroad station stands a sorry cluster of barracks, sagging, cheerless and forlorn.

In these dreary quarters are housed some of the most sorrowful remnants of the past war world. Displaced Persons over whom the tides of UNRRA and IRO have subsided, leaving them in their ugly barracks like driftwood on the European beach.

Ironically, some of the most degrading refugees form this last core.

For refugees are of different sorts: There are the German minorities from the Eastern Countries, thrown out by the post-war governments. They find a refuge in West Germany.

There are the Jews—they have a new, if overcrowded homeland in Israel. But the refugees across from the Salzburg station are Russians.

**FATHER MARKEL**, a red-haired giant with a Jeremiah beard, orthodox priest for the barracks community, shook his head when I asked about the morale in the camp.

"You must try to imagine what it is like not to dare to have hopes or plans and to live in constant fear of the Russian army," he said.

"Most of these people have been in these miserable barracks for five years, without knowing from one week to the next what would become of them.

"And the fear, you must understand that these people are not stateless. They are Soviet citizens who face treatment as traitors if they fall into Russian hands.

"They know that only 50 miles east of here Russian sentries are standing.

"DO YOU KNOW, many of these will refuse to report themselves sick, because that means going to the hospital in Linz, which is closer to the Soviet Zone.

"It is very difficult to help these people. They have experienced all the demoralizing consequences of

emigration and crowded, unimproved camps in the USSR were "Sins do not seem so bad to them, and the church has little importance in their lives now."

"It is popular to think that the church is strengthened in times of adversity, but I am afraid it is not always so."

Father Markel then related how the churches in the USSR were turned to other uses before the war, now in the Ukraine he had seen churches used as warehouses, movie theaters, and machine shops.

**HE FELT THAT** the lack of religious education had opened the way for a mixture of superstition with what remained of the present, and complained that the refugees had lost the habit of relying on the church.

He paused, then continued in a stern voice.

"If this people in America should know about these Russians. Some of them of course are rascals who collaborated with the German army in Russia.

"But many of them have only the crime of disliking the present Soviet government. Unfortunately, he hopes that they had when they fled, had disappeared.

**"SOVIET AGENTS** are constantly at work in the camp, promising money to those who will do undercover work for the Communists now.

The people know that this is a lie, that if the Red Army comes west, they will be shot anyway but in their desperation some of them have given in and are working for the very forces they fled from.

"Why is it not possible to make a new home for these people in America? After all, they have done what Americans would like all Russians to do. They have withdrawn their support from the Soviet government.

"For doing that, they have won five years in these rotting barracks. They put their faith in the West. Sometimes I must wonder if you haven't let them down."
