

Crane Grid Squad Defeats Nichols For First Win

Aided by three touchdowns by Jim Simpson, Cranbrook defeated Nichols school of Buffalo Saturday morning 20-19 in a varsity game.

Midway in the first quarter, Simpson took a pass from John Edson and scampered 73 yards for the Cranes' first score. Jack Knoblock converted.

Shortly after the beginning of the second period, Pete Hochreiter raced a total of 54 yards for two Nichols tallies. Hochreiter was

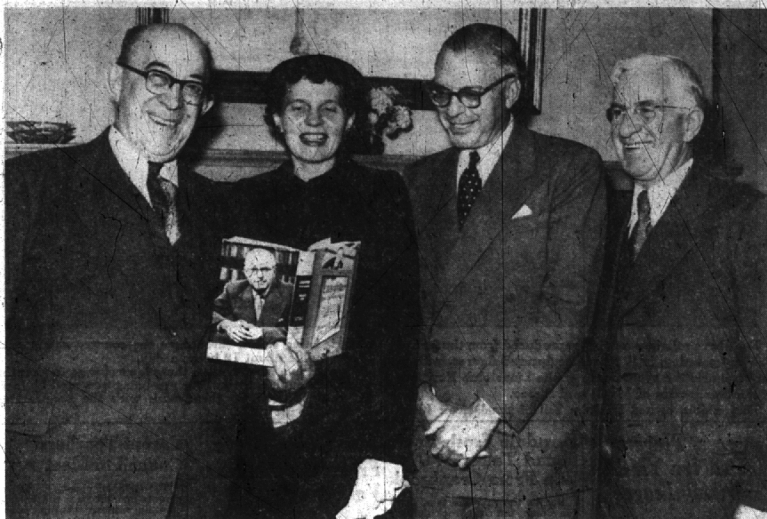
successful on the second conversion.

IN THE THIRD quarter, Hochreiter passed to Obeckircher and Bill Crowley went 39 yards off tackle for the third Nichols score. Hochreiter's missed conversion proved to be the losing point as Cranbrook immediately drove to the Big Green's six yard line where Knoblock passed to Simpson for Simpson's second tally.

The third score came in the fourth quarter when Simpson went 20 yards around end on a double-reverse tying the game at 19. Knoblock then converted for a 20-19 victory for Cranbrook.

This was the Cranes' first victory in five attempts.

Baldwin's Special Gift Books Go On Display Today

Beginning today and continuing through Nov. 11, Baldwin Library has on display a number of books which it has received as gifts during the past two years.

A number of the books are from the Friends of Baldwin Library while the rest have been given in honor and memory of local residents.

Last June the Friends' board voted funds to increase the section on American history and since that time 50 outstanding books have been added.

Among them are Blackford's "War Years With Job Stuart," Holbrook's "Yankee Exodus" and Catherine Drinker Bowen's "John Adams and the American Revolution."

DURING THE PAST two years the library has received over a hundred books for its Memorial Collection. Although normally of older classification, these books have been temporarily grouped as a collection for public display.

and donor. All will be out of circulation during the exhibit period.
