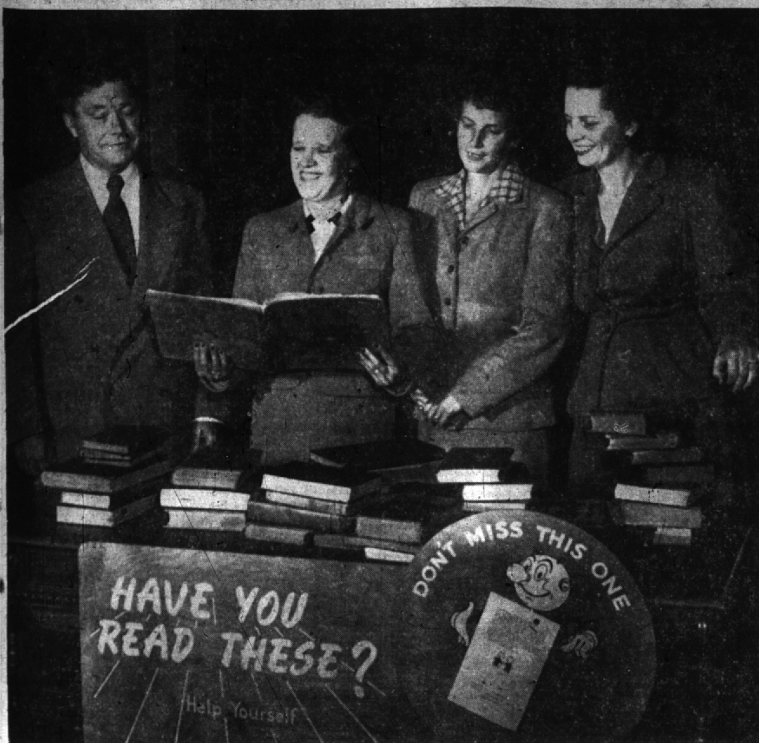


Members of the A.A.U.W. View First Editions To Appear in Annual Book Sale

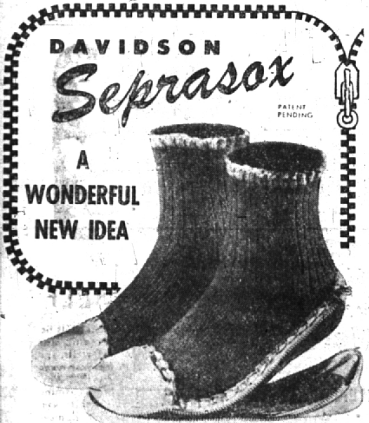
