

Democrat—the Southern Kind—Named GOP State Alternate for Second Time

A previous commitment will prevent Mrs. F. G. Garrison, 3970 W. Maple, a Democratic candidate for state representative from this district, from attending Saturday's Republican state convention in Grand Rapids.

She was named an alternate GOP convention delegate at the Oakland county convention Monday.

"But I honestly feel highly complimented by being named," she declared yesterday morning. "I am as interested in the Republican

voters as much as I am in the Democrats."

MRS. VELMA CADY of Pleasant Ridge, a member of the committee which submitted Mrs. Garrison's name along with those for 97 other alternates, explained,

"Mrs. Garrison's name was on the February 1949 list which the county convention approved as an alternative delegate. We heard nothing from Mrs. Garrison then so we assumed she still was a Republican."

When informed of her selection on the 1949 list, Mrs. Garrison commented, "No one informed me about it then, otherwise I would have made it known at that time. After all, I'm originally from Louisiana—one of those Southern Democrats."
