

# Federal Insurance Coverage Doubled, Bank Announces

The Birmingham Federal Savings and Loan association announced today that, effective immediately, Federal insurance coverage will be provided on all savings up to \$10,000. The new maximum coverage was \$5,000.00.

Walter L. Moreland, president, said the increased coverage follows the signing into law by President Truman of legislation boosting insurance protection for associations with savings accounts insured by the Federal Savings and Loan Insurance corporation.

"Our association will bear all the cost of protection for our customers," said Moreland. "The new law affords us the opportunity of securing a further safeguard for the funds of our savers."
