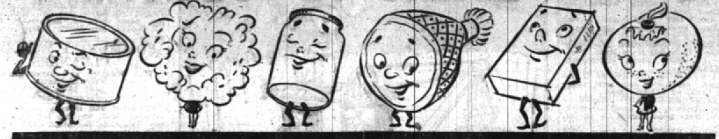

**HORSE SENSE AND NONSENSE**

**WE, THE PEOPLE**  
 To borrow a phrase, "We, the People" are the watchdogs of America. We have the responsibility of protecting our own interests and those of our neighbors. This responsibility comes as a request from J. Edgar Hoover. A request that you and I join with the FBI as they wage their cold war against those who would destroy our way of life.

**WE ARE THEN** asked to become the local agents in a series of the country's watchdogs. To bid them in their constant search for saboteurs and subversive agents. In a nation-wide news release, J. Edgar Hoover incorporated all new agencies in the battle. He asked that they carry the message from the FBI to Americans all over the country. The message contained the information as to how we could help protect our nation. Hoover asks us to report incidents which we feel are of importance to his department. They ask that we give them truthful, unbiased information. They ask that we do not judge in haste, but pass it on as we know it. We are not being asked to spy upon our neighbors but to help them—and ourselves.

**THEIR RELEASE** stresses that we should report facts, whether they seem important or not. A very small item may be the final evidence needed by the department to stop wide-spread subversive action. They ask us to tell them, and then, to all intents and purposes forget about them. Hoover points out that the agents of the FBI are carefully selected men who undergo extensive training for their work. They are accustomed to sifting information and checking details for importance. They may appear to be slack on a case, but it is deliberate. By letting the lesser figures in a group continue their activities without molestation, the FBI may spin a web around the more powerful figures. To arrest the smaller men would be to reveal their interest and have the whole case collapse then and there.

**FBI AGENTS** admit our intentions may be good when we try to carry on an investigation of our own. They appreciate the fact that we may be trying to avoid sending them useless information. However, they ask that we leave that to the men who have studied and become experts in their field. We are asked not to spread rumor. Should we hear of something which seems important, listen carefully, and report it to their offices. Do not cherish it as an office or bridge club tid-bit. If important, our constant repeating may twist and warp it to the point of being useless. If unimportant, or worse still, untrue, repeated many times a rumor can become a terrible thing. It can be detrimental to our country at large, and extremely damaging to innocent persons or groups.

**AT FIRST** glance, it may seem that the FBI has entrusted us with a terrific responsibility. It may seem that they are asking us to face a huge task. Actually, they are merely asking that we act as Americans, proud of the freedoms our country offers us and happy in its opportunities. They are asking us to cherish these things as highly as we cherish any personal possession. These men are aware that they cannot cover every section of the country completely. They know that they are working against enemies who are as care-

fully trained as they are. They know, too, that many of the persons who are working against American interests are doing so in all innocence.

**THESE, ACTUALLY,** are as dangerous as the trained saboteur for they are like amateurs and guns. They're not aware of the power of the instrument they have in their hands. FBI agents need your help. They are as near to you as the closest telephone. They are not asking that we do their work for them they simply want us to help them in their job of protecting us.
