City's Share of SOHA Budget Set At \$1,688.39

Birmingham's share of the South Oakland Hospital authority budget for the next year will be \$1,688.39. The apportionment amounts to one-twentieth of one mill on each dollar of equalized assessed valuation, based on the 1950 county equalization report.

The authority's budget has been set at \$11,444.86 for the fiscal year from May 1, 1961 to April 30, 1962.

Apportionments for other municipalities are Berkeley, \$1,243.45; Clawson, \$226.60; Ferndale, \$2,326.18; Hazel Park, \$817.59; Huntingwood, \$656.62; Pleasant Ridge, \$407.25; Royal Oak, \$3,408.23; Royal Oak township, \$531.27; and Troy township, \$398.91.

Proclamation Sets Music Week Dates

Music Week in Michigan will be observed May 6-13, as part of a national program.

Mrs. D. L. Tate, 959 Westchester Way, state chairman of Music Week, has received an official proclamation for its observance from Gov. G. Mennen Williams. The proclamation reads in part: "Never has the world had greater need for music than today. Never have the people of America more surely needed the encouragement and comfort music gives."

"... IT IS MOST fitting that Michigan, with its many music lovers and musical organizations, should join in this nation-wide observance."

Music Week has been celebrated annually since 1924.

Pontiac Hospital's Proposal Rejected By Commissioners

Birmingham officials voted against entering an agreement with Pontiac General hospital Monday, regarding payment for persons taken there as "emergencies."

Police Chief Ralph W. Moxley pointed out that nearly every emergency case leaving Birmingham is taken to St. Joseph Mercy hospital.

Commissioner Dean Beier said he felt W. K. Willman, Pontiac city manager, should present figures, based on experience, before expecting the city to enter into any agreement. He added that he felt hospital authorities should be told that payment would be forthcoming any time a bill was presented to the commission.

MILTON MALLENDER commented that, in fairness to Pontiac, any emergency cases taken there by the city should be paid by the city, adding that he felt Willman's statement was more of a broadside sent to everyone. Believing it was meant more for communities to the south, City Manager Donald C. Egbert said he did not recall any such bills ever being received here.

The board of trustees of the First Presbyterian church has withdrawn its petition requesting removal of the parkway on Larchlea drive, adjacent to Maple avenue.

In a communication addressed to the city commission, A. S. McCall of the board said his group is in accord with the commission's recommendation that the petition be withdrawn.

Quill and Scroll Members Selected

In recognition of distinguished work on publications, five Baldwin students were recently elected to Quill and Scroll, international journalism society for high school journalists.

Cris Adams, advertising manager of all school publications; Bill Aikens, business manager; Barb Stradinger, sales manager; and Robin Renfrew and Ann Morrow, co-editors of the yearbook, were recommended to Quill and Scroll at Medill school of journalism, Northwestern University, and were approved by the executive secretary of the society.

Second Hearing Set to Consider Building Code

Second and final hearing to consider the new proposed city building code has been set for May 7.

First hearing was held at Monday's commission meeting. Among those present were the members of the code committee, Building Inspector Barkley Omans and Detroit Building Commissioner Joseph Wolf.

Bradley Pruden, code committee chairman, stated it is an entirely new code based on the Building Officials Conference of America code.

He pointed out that it is a performance code rather than relating to specification, thus allowing for advances in construction. Some objections were raised during the hearing, questioning the legality of the code.

No official action was taken by school board members at the April 17 meeting on the request of Donald Nelson to purchase lots on the east side of the high school site. Nelson owns other properties in the Lincoln-Cranbrook area.
