Building Code Hearing Date Set

A hearing to consider any objections to the new proposed city building code will be held April 23.

CITY MANAGER Donald C. Egbert stated that a report will be submitted to the city commission outlining the requirements of the board of appeals (building code), zoning board of appeals, and electrical board of examiners.

Objective of the code is to make the effective regulation of building construction possible and to establish minimum requirements for safe, permanent construction of buildings and structures within the range of building operations in a residential community.

Bradley Frenon, chairman of the building code committee, said the code is the result of 10 months of research, study and discussion by the committee. He pointed out that it takes into consideration the city's size and character.

OTHER BUILDING codes, both national and local in scope, have been studied for ideas to incorporate into the new code, he said.

Egbert stated Monday evening that the building code committee should be commended on the final draft and in the "thoroughness with which it has been prepared."
