The Rev. Keller, a noted author and lecturer, is best known for his work in founding the Christopher movement in 1945. His description of the group and its aims points out that the approach of Christopher, or Christopher, is a positive rather than negative one. Instead of concentrating on driving evil persons from influential fields, the Christopher enters the field himself, and works to restore it to its proper value.

Membership in the organization carries no fees, dues or subscriptions. Rev. Keller has written several well-known books, including "You Can Change the World," which was made into a motion picture under his supervision.

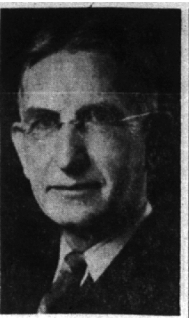

Effect of Resources On People to be Told By Unitarian Guest

Birmingham Unitarian Fellowship members will hear an address by Dean Dana, of the school of Forestry, University of Michigan, will speak on "Natural Resources and People," outlining the opportunities presented in Michigan.

The dean was forest commissioner in Maine for several years and has done extensive research in forestry. He was also a member of the task force on natural resources, a commission organized by the federal government and as captain in the army, attached to the general staff division in charge of lumber statistics. In addition to this he was secretary to the commodity committee on lumber and is also listed in "Who's Who" as one of the nation's outstanding men as a forest economist.

Public Hearing Set For Zoning Changes In Southfield Twp.

Two proposed changes in the Southfield township zoning ordinance will be considered at a public hearing in the Southfield school building at Berg roads, Thursday evening, April 5, at 8 a.m. Under consideration is a change

in rezoning of a 320-acre parcel between Northwestern, Evergreen and Nine Mile roads. Residents have requested that this area be rezoned from residence three to four. This would mean a change in minimum requirements of homes from 10,000 to 12,000 cubic feet. Also to be discussed will be a change in the ordinance making it unlawful to maintain dog or cat kennels or raise livestock on a parcel of land less than 10 acres.
