Fire Chief Wants More Enforcement

In view of several fires which have been started by children in partially completed homes, Fire Chief V. W. Griffith is asking greater enforcement of city building ordinances.

He pointed out that one section of the recently adopted building code states clearly that contractors shall not allow inflammable material to collect on a job.

"It's always a temptation to children," Griffith said, "to start a fire when they see a supply of paper and dry wood around and know where they can get matches."

"In most homes the latter are pretty easily come by, and in some of the recent fires at Birmingham, the youngsters have used matches left in the building by the workmen."

Griffith will also ask that contractors be required to close all houses once the walls are closed in. "When the outer walls are on a house and the first insulation has been put on, that house is a perfect set-up for a fast, hot fire. Some insulations are fire proof, others are so light and of an inflammable material that lighting a match to them is like lighting a stick of dynamite," Griffith said.

"This was the case of the recent fire in Glenhurst. The boy who started it found matches in the building. The insulation had a thin paper on one side and a tar impregnated backing next to the outer wall. It went like tinder once it started."

"The whole interior of the building was open and carried the flames to the roof. The asphalt base of the roofing paper just added to it. It is beyond my comprehension how the boy escaped."

Griffith said the fire was reported only about 10 minutes after the workmen had left and when the department arrived it had spread through the entire building.

Griffith said that a record was kept of children responsible for the fires, and that none were found to be repeaters.

"It's simply a case of everything presenting itself and a child thoughtlessly going on to find out what he can do."

He pointed out that his two requests—less scrap material left lying around and the closing of all openings when workers leave, would probably put a stop to most future blazes of this nature.

Tree Removal Request Granted by Commission

Commissioners approved a Consumer Power request for removal of two trees in front of their proposed new building site at Henrietta and Merrill.

A 12-inch elm will be removed at the company's expense and will be replaced by a smaller tree to be planted in a location selected by the city forester.

The second tree, a 30-inch maple on the Merrill street side of the property will be removed at the city's expense.

Commissioners were informed that this tree was hindering the growth of a smaller and more desirable tree only 10 feet away.
