

## Rising Satisfied Overtime Parking Problem Not Bad

Commissioner Frank Rising said Monday night he was satisfied that extended parking in metered zones is not as serious as he had believed.

Rising referred to those motorists who park for longer than the legal limit and avoid getting a violations ticket by returning at intervals to put additional coins in the meters.

Several weeks ago he asked Police Chief Ralph W. Mosley to determine how serious this problem was in Birmingham.

Checks made July 16, 18 and 19 showed some violations but not an alarming number. Another survey Aug. 6 of 190 cars showed three still parked after 30 hours and 15 minutes and one after an hour and 30 minutes.

"THE SITUATION is not as bad as I thought," Rising said, "and it eases our minds if it is no worse than this every day. As Chief Mosley said, it is not a bad problem but one which needs some further enforcement."

## Petitioners Withdraw Request for Pavement

A petition presented on July 2 requesting pavement on Pleasant Road, Lincoln to Northaven and on Fairway drive for that portion included in the Northaven Heights subdivision has been withdrawn and the special assessment district abandoned. The Aug. 13 hearing also was cancelled by the city commission.

This action was taken after residents reconsidered their request and decided a pavement for the area was not necessary.
