Pre-School Vision Test Is Planned

Tentative plans have been made by the Birmingham branch of the Junior League to operate a vision testing center for pre-school children.

This was revealed last week when Mrs. Thomas Snelham, representative to the Community Council, cleared such a project through the council to certain that such a community service was not already being done by other agencies.

"Everyone we have talked to about this project has been most enthusiastic," stated Mrs. Snelham. "We have found that there are over 3000 pre-school children in Birmingham. By the time a child is under the school vision testing program, the doctors feel that in some instances it is too late to do much because patterns have been set.

FORMAL APPROVAL by the Junior League still must be obtained for this program, Mrs. Snelham emphasized.

"The Community House is willing to let us use one of their rooms to house the center and the Junior Leaguers who will volunteer help will be trained. A pre-school vision testing center is rather a new thing, as there are very few of these centers in the country," she said.

City Forestry Dept. to Start Tree Trimming

Approximately 400 trees, mostly hard maples, were planted in Birmingham this fall during the planting program of the city forestry department.

City Forester Bill Lebold said this week that the planting is completed and his nine-man department now will start its winter program, which includes an extensive amount of tree trimming.

Lebold stated, "We'll first fill the backlog of requests received for tree trimming and then the department will start in on streets."

In Birmingham, each tree is usually trimmed once each 12 years. The forester said that there are 15,000 trees and only about 1,000 can be trimmed a year.

LEBOLD ESTIMATES that one man can trim about two average size trees a day. Although some emergency trimming is done throughout the year, the major part is accomplished during the winter months.

Another winter time task of the forestry crew is carrying off the various city ice rinks. Lebold said that weather conditions will probably permit the rinks to be flooded in mid-December.

Last winter, despite the changing weather conditions, several youths were able to get quite a bit of good skating in during their Christmas vacation.

The forester stated, "We'll do all we can to see that the kids get to skate as soon as possible."

November Fire Reports Shows Losses Stay Low

Birmingham has recorded another month of extremely low fire damage, according to Chief V. W. Griffith. Damages on buildings were estimated at \$20, and on contents, \$250. This includes a general alarm on Nov. 23 when fire broke out at the McClellan and Ball feed store on Brownell.

The department answered 30 silent alarms for fires and fire investigations, two for gas investigations, one first aid and one general.
