New Exhibits At Cranbrook Science Inst.

Electrically activated large models of fire flies, a model of a green-bottle fly, 24 times natural size, with moving "gyroscopes", bat radar and a plant acting as an animal trap were among the new exhibits unveiled Friday night before about 600 members of the Cranbrook Institute of Science, Bloomfield Hills. These constitute a new area of exhibits on nature's invention. In an adjacent case are another new exhibition dealing with the three contrasting patterns of organization of living things which to a large extent controlled the success of animal or plant groups possessing them. Here there are numerous striking preparations, ranging from models in plastic of microscopic animals, to a spray of orchids, created in wax to a degree of fidelity adequate to deceive an insect.

IN THE MINERALS area of the museum is a special display of stones ornamentally used in silver. Many newly acquired minerals are also being shown, including three exceptionally large specimens of Australian opals. The National Lead Company has a special exhibition of Titania gems including stones of colors not commercially available, and up to a size of 85 carats.

Among the new Indian exhibits are a large showing of objects from the Navajo, Pueblo and Apache. An interesting feature of this exhibit is a scale model of a Hopi pueblo on top of a mesa. Another case deals with the Eskimo as carvers of bone and ivory and contained objects made by these people through the last 3,000 years.

One display reconstructs an archaeologist's "dig" on top of Starved Rock, LaSalle's outpost on the Illinois River, which has served as a natural citadel since man first invaded the Midwest. The exhibits are open to the public from 2 to 5 p.m. daily, after Friday, Nov. 30.
