Pianist Is Guest Soloist at Annual Concert of Chorus

Elsie Kohlenstein, pianist, will be guest soloist for the Birmingham Male Chorus at its annual concert Dec. 11. The program will be presented at 8 o'clock Tuesday evening in the Community House. Miss Kohlenstein is a graduate of the music department of Western State college at Kalamazoo. She has also studied for several years under Margaret Mannsbach in Detroit, and for the past three summers at the American Conservatory in Fontainebleau, France. Her concert selections will include Schubert's Impromptu in E Flat, Arabesque and Aufschubung by Schuman. The chorus will present a program of secular and popular music, spirituals, folk songs, and several numbers appropriate to the Christmas season. Featured vocalists will be Robert Irwin, Elmer Rosenberger, Carleton Scott, Lawrence Smith. Otto Brown, instructor of music in Ferris schools, is the director.

India Art Exhibit Now At Cranbrook

An exhibition entitled "Indian Watercolor Drawings of the Kalighat school" will be on view at the Museum of Cranbrook Academy of Art from Dec. 8 to Jan. 9. The exhibition is lent by the Wadia worth Athenaeum in Hartford, Conn. and circulated under the auspices of the American Federation of Arts. The exhibition, consisting of 43 watercolor by Indian artists, represents the work of the Kalighat school, a group of local Bengal artists which was active during the latter part of the 19th century and died out about 1910. They took their name from the Kalighat, the great temple of Kali, female counterpart of Siva and goddess of death, and a central shrine of the Hindu religion in Calcutta. During the years of the activity, they made their paintings on the steps of this temple and sold them to pilgrims for about one anna each. THE PRINCIPAL subjects of the paintings are Hindu artists, and goddesses, animals and fish and domestic scenes which include considerable emphasis on episodes involving domestic friction. The exhibition will be shown in 10 United States Museums from coast to coast. The Museum will be closed from Dec. 24 through Jan. 1.
