Villa Rezoning Recommended by Planning Board

The city plan board has recommended that property owned by Lincoln Construction Co. on the south side of Villa, between Columbus and Edgewood, be rezoned from single home to income bungalow.

The firm plans to erect eight duplex units. They will be one-story ranch type with the "appearance of a single home."

Original proposal of the company was to replat the 14 lots into 10 duplex sites, but this idea was not accepted by the board. Reason was that 20 families would be using land zoned for 14 families.
