**City Concerned With Off-Street Parking Financing**

The city commission has instructed City Manager Donald C. Egbert to consult with Forbes S. Hascall, city attorney, concerning a proposed letter to the Michigan Municipal League indicating Birmingham's interest in certain amendments to the Revenue bond act.

Hascall, after a study of state statutes regarding the financing of off-street parking facilities, suggests that Act 236 of the Public Acts of 1947 might be amended, rather than amending the Revenue bond act.

Hascall stated that section one of the act can be amended by including a provision that a municipality could finance off-street parking facilities by the issuance of revenue bonds, or by special assessments a gainst property benefited, or by a combination of both.

He also suggested that proceeds from special assessments could be deducted for purposes of such financing and that the same could be pledged for payment of bonds.

Amendment to Building Code No. 119 of the Township of Southfield, Oakland County, Michigan.

Whereas, the Township of Southfield, County of Oakland, Michigan, Ordinance No. 2054, four hundred and ninety-four, of the year 1947, which ordinance provides for the erection, alteration, repair, or attachment to a single lot of all walls, partitions, or other masonry construction and the ceiling of any, is not of sufficient construction and strength to insure the safety of the structure and the health of the occupants thereof, and whereas, it is deemed expedient to amend said ordinance so that the thickness of said plaster to be measured from back of lath shall be not less than two layers of 5/8 inch lath, or with two layers of 3/4 inch lath, or with two layers of 5/8 inch lath.

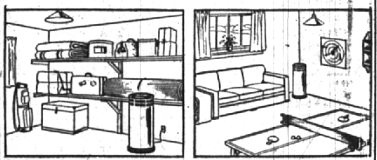
