Hills Board Awards Wing Lake School Addition Contracts

Contracts for the construction of an addition to the Wing Lake school were awarded by the Bloomfield Hills school board Monday evening.
Cost of constructing the additional two rooms, corridor and entrance will be approximately \$68,000, according to Superintendent John Jacobs.
He said the present building is inadequate to accommodate all the students in the Wing Lake area. At the present time, kindergarten and fifth and sixth grade pupils from that district are attending Bloomfield Hills school.
Jacobs said 82 students are now attending Wing Lake school. After the enlargement, about 100 to 120 are expected.
The construction contract was awarded to the Scherrer Construction Co. of Pontiac; electrical work to Shaw Electrical Co., and mechanical to the Thornton company.

Snow Removal Costs To Exceed Estimates
It appears snow removal costs for the fiscal year will exceed estimates, city commissioners learned Monday.
A total of \$12,000 had been appropriated but because of heavy snow falls during January, total expenditures through Feb. 8 were \$11,112.51.
Commissioners approved City Manager Donald C. Egbert's recommendation that in the event of further heavy snow-fall or ice conditions, the DPW proceed with snow removal and report any appropriation deficiency to the commission, together with a request for additional funds.

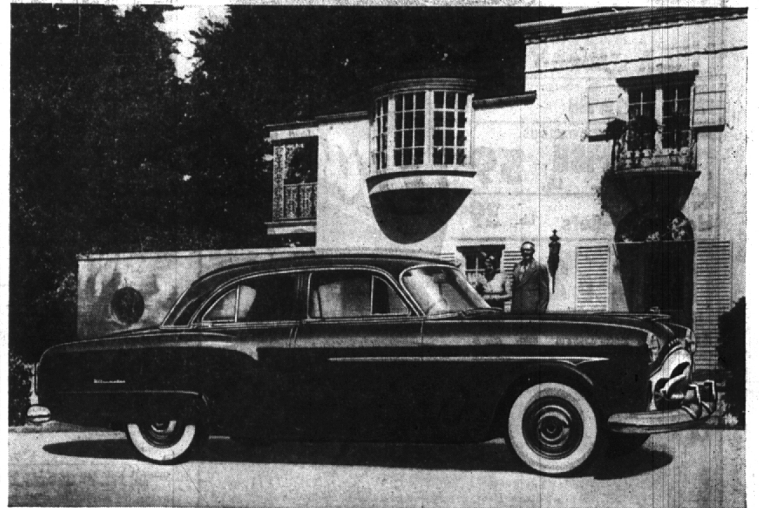
