How the Army flew him out of Seoul, Korea, shortly after the North Korean Reds attacked last June was described to Birmingham Rotarians this week by Milton Turner, ECA member in charge of industrial training and service engineering instruction.

"The Korean economic and political situation looked hopeful at the time the Reds struck," he declared. "Recent letters from my Korean friends want to know when I am coming back to continue the training program. They want no part of communism."
