

Southfield Twp. Civilian Defense Plans Stated

Mrs. Emon Rutledge of the Southfield township Republican Women's club appeared at the township board meeting Tuesday evening and asked what has been done on civilian defense measures. Supervisor D. P. Frame said he will talk with the newly appointed director of civilian defense in the state this week. He also said the township fire department is reorganizing a volunteer organization and he has conferred with state health and state highway department representatives.

THE SUPERVISOR pointed out that the latter two organizations are yet to have definite civilian defense plans. He also said the Southfield American Legion post has offered its assistance in any program.

Frame said he will arrange a joint meeting between the township board and the planning commission to make further plans.

In other business, the board approved a motion by Hugh C. White, that upon application, the board should refund reinspection fees which have been paid.

This action was taken after a request was received from Forbes S. Haswell, representing Gus Sigmund. The letter pointed out Sigmund has paid \$10 for five reinspection fees and if there was no provision in the building ordinance for reinspection fees, the money should be refunded.

The board approved a motion by Treasurer Clara Lane that the penalty on special assessment payments two and eight be waived until Feb. 28.

Slide Authorized For Colerain By Troy School Board

The Troy township school board authorized William H. Schroeder, assistant superintendent of schools, to purchase a new slide for Colerain school at its meeting Tuesday evening.

Schroeder stated that the board also paid a certificate for \$44,000 to the Fredman Construction Co., as part payment for the new high school building.

Radiators for the new building arrived Tuesday. After they are installed, it will be possible for much of the inside work to be done, Schroeder pointed out.
