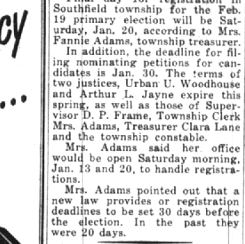

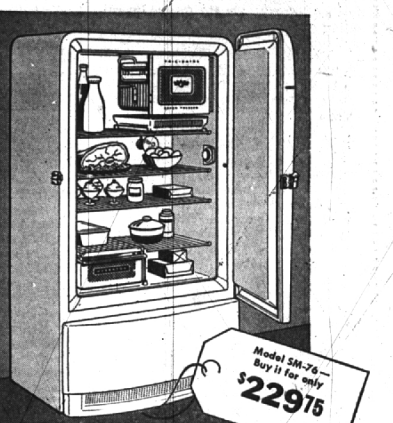
Harry J. Klingler Honored at Dinner
