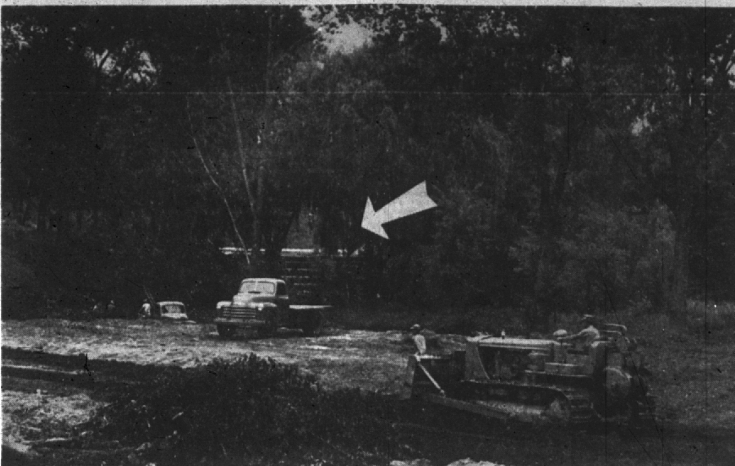

Egbert Stresses Need for Capital Imp. Program

The city commission must shortly establish a priority rating for its capital improvement program, and then fit the projects into a financing program that will maintain the credit rating of the city, City Manager Donald C. Egbert told Rotary Club members Monday noon.

Egbert was introduced by former city plan commissioner Dr. Robert Mason. Subject of the talk was "Your City in 1951."

That year, the city debt was re-funded and the city started anew, he said.

He pointed out that the city was static between 1933-1937, as projects were restricted to facing the city's needs and reestablishing credit. Between 1940 and 1951, the per capita debt has been decreased from \$95 to \$38.92.

The city manager said the present policy is to finance most capital improvements through the annual budget and only major projects by bond issues.

HE BELIEVES a medium ground for financing capital improvements could be established, between pay-as-you-go and bonds. He emphasized the city's rapid growth will require some portion by bonds.

Egbert is discussing improvements needed, said that very little money had been spent to safeguard tree-lined streets. He said a considerable amount will have to be appropriated to give the attention needed.
