Once again men facing the draft have an opportunity to select the branch of the service they prefer to enter. Through July 15 men who have passed their pre-induction physical examinations and have not yet been called up may enlist in the branch they desire.
Because of the over-load on the downtown recruiting offices, the Air Force has decided to open the facilities of its nearby bases to handle enlistees choosing the Air Force.
COL. JAMES R. GUNN, JR., commanding officer of Selfridge Air Force Base, announced that those men who elect to enter the Air Force from this area can enlist directly at Selfridge. The recruiting office on the base will process enlistments there for all enlistees through July 15th.
Previously, the pre-induction physical exam disqualified the prospective conscript from entering his preferred branch of service. Enlistment in the branch of his choice had to be accomplished prior to the examination.
Entrance into the Air Force at Selfridge does not mean that the enlistee will remain there, the Colonel pointed out. All airmen will go to training centers from the base for basic training.

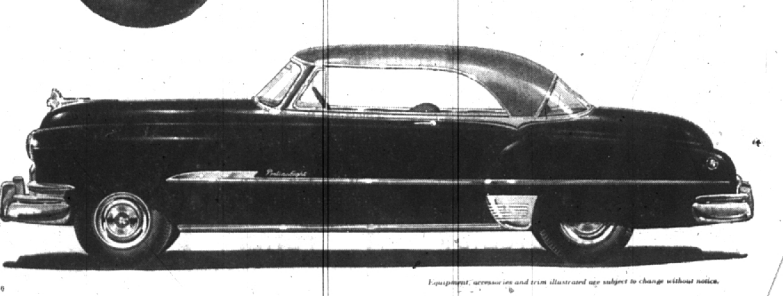
