Two Exhibitions At Cranbrook Art Museum July 20

Two exhibitions will open Friday, July 20, at the Cranbrook Academy of Art, Bloomfield Hills. "Paintings by Soutine" will be on display until Aug. 5 and "Paris Exhibition Posters" through Aug. 15.

The Soutine Exhibition includes 25 major works by the expressionist painter, Chaim Soutine. Curated by the Museum of Modern Art, the exhibition has been drawn from American and foreign collections, and covers the entire span of his creative life from 1916 to 1942.

The artist, born in Russia in 1894, studied and painted in Paris most of his life. His artistic work, grouped together with that of Picasso, Utrillo and Modigliani, belongs to a school of painting highly expressive of the dramatic contrasts and clashes in humanity and nature.

His first important exhibition in this country was held at the Arts Club of Chicago in 1935, and in 1940 the Museum of Modern Art and the Cleveland Museum of Art prepared a major retrospective exhibition of which the Cranbrook

Museum presents a significant selection.

Shown concurrently at the Museum with the Soutine exhibition are posters as works of art, designed by many of the foremost artists of the School of Paris. The "Paris Exhibition Posters" comprise 61 limited edition posters made in the past few years to call attention to one-man shows of the artists themselves or to group exhibitions.

There are lithographic designs by Picasso, Braque, Matisse, Miró, Léger and other contemporary French artists.

Museum hours are daily except Mondays from two to five.
