Dance, Drama, Music Combined To Stage "Trinity In Tears"

Trinity In Tears, a dance-drama in two acts and fifteen scenes, attempts to unite smoothly, dialogue, dance, and music. The characters will sometimes speak while dancing to music, other times dance to music, speak to music, speak unaccompanied, and so on through the entire range of possible combinations. Music and dance are composed to strengthen the mood of the scenes; musical themes are employed for main characters and are composed so as to augment and clarify the personality of the character.

The story of the dance-drama is that of a young man, a Christian figure in modern dress, and the reactions to him of the members of a modern urban community. A second plot concerns the relation of the young man and a girl he has healed. Throughout the drama she is a loyal companion to him
