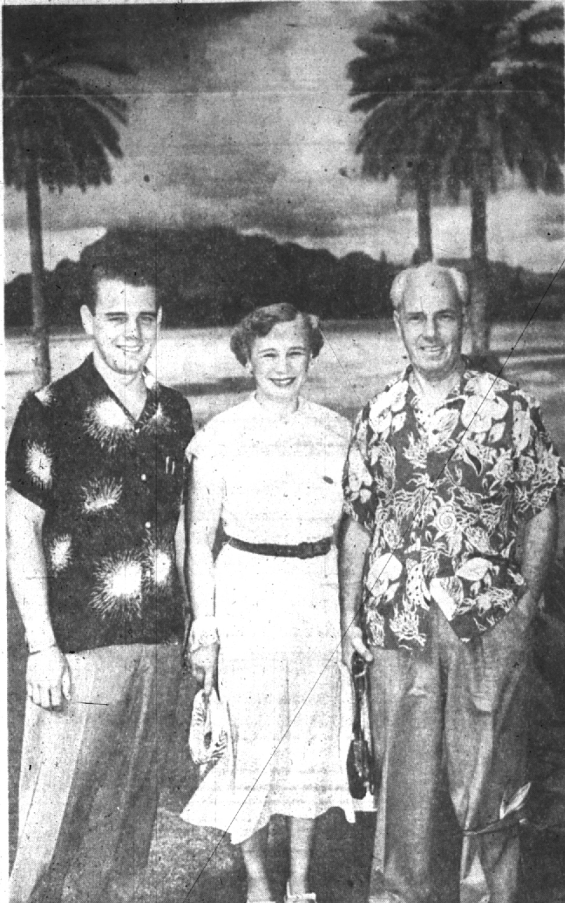

Street Vacation To Be Discussed At Aug. 27 Meet

Vacation of Lawndale avenue, north of Madison, will be discussed at a public hearing Aug. 27. The portion of land between Hunter and Lawndale is owned by the city and was acquired for park purposes. The area is rough and because of old sidewalks and previous street grading, it is impossible to maintain properly, according to Donald C. Egbert, city manager. He said it is part of the city's plan to clean up the area, remove unwanted trees and make a suitable planting in order that it could become a part of the Poppleton park property.

IT HAS BEEN suggested to the lot owner on the east that Lawndale be vacated and a triangular parcel of the street area 25 feet in width on the south end be attached to this lot. A similar parcel at the other end would be retained by the city.

Egbert and the lot owner had indicated a willingness to execute such a suit claim deed. The city also proposed to erect a four foot chain link fence along the new division of the property. Egbert pointed out that this would give a pedestrian entrance to Poppleton park. He added that a vehicular entrance was deemed unwise because of its closeness to Hunter boulevard.

Commissioners Approve \$12,723 As City's Share In Assessment Districts
Commissioners have approved appropriations of \$12,723 from Birmingham's capital fund to pay the city's share in six special assessment districts.

Most of the property in the districts is publicly owned, including school property and parks. "Most of the work involved in these assessment districts has been completed," City Manager Donald C. Egbert said, "and the balance is either under construction or will be constructed in the next few years. The only exception is the Birmingham Crestview pavement and we have no schedule for paving Shurman boulevard at the present time. Other items are the Lincoln-Purdy sewer, Etou sidewalk, Pembroke Home pavement, Fenbrook A.C. surfacing and the St. Andrew Edenborough relief sewer.

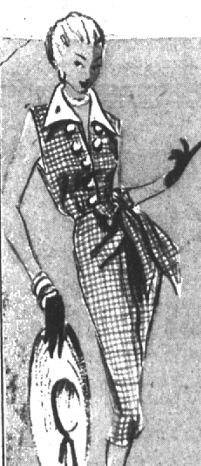
