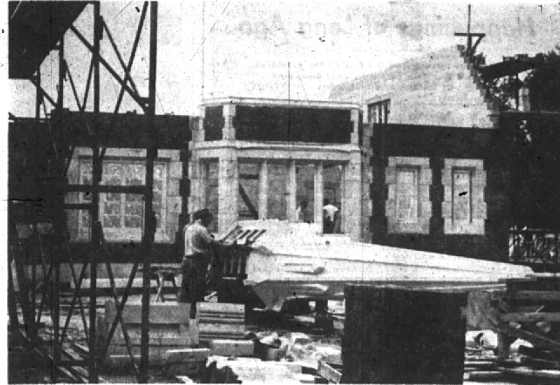

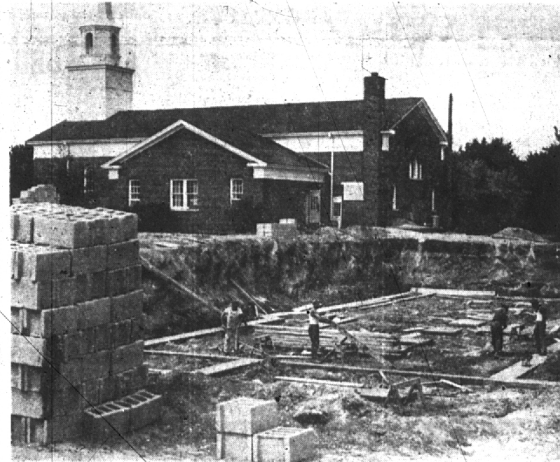

ROTC Students At Summer Camp

FORT BLISS—William G. Plant, and George T. Trumbull, Jr. are attending the annual Fort Bliss ROTC Camp to complete field training requirements for a commission as second lieutenant in Antiaircraft Artillery, Army Reserve Corps.

These cadets are among over 1800 ROTC cadets from 28 colleges and universities in the United States and Puerto Rico, the first time that all antiaircraft college ROTC units have trained together.

During the encampment, which lasts six weeks, the cadets will receive instruction and practical training in the use of the 40-mm and 90-mm antiaircraft guns, gunnery, small arms, and in troop leadership.

These cadets are students at Michigan State College.

H. L. Woolfenden Named State Bar Commissioner

LANSING—July 19.—Attorney Henry L. Woolfenden of Kensington road, Bloomfield Hills, has been appointed Commissioner of the State Bar of Michigan, Joseph C. Plank, Lansing, president of the State Bar announced today.

Selection was made by unanimous vote of the State Bar board

of Commissioners, according to Plank. The term expires in 1953.

A new congressional district was created by the 1951 Michigan Legislature. The appointment of Woolfenden followed action by the Supreme Court of Michigan which increased the number of State Bar Commissioners from 21 to 22 to permit representation from the new district.

WOOLFENDEN served the bar previously as its first executive secretary from 1936-42, accepting that appointment following graduation from Detroit College of Law and private practice in Pontiac.

He has since served on various committees of the organization and is a delegate to the American Bar Association, Plank said.

Woolfenden, from his experience in private practice as a partner in the Detroit firm of Dahlberg, Simon, Jayne, Woolfenden & Gawne and his government service as a member of various boards and commissions including two years on the Michigan Public Service Commission, brings a wealth of valuable experience to his new appointment", Plank pointed out.
